Participation in Chapter Dance Programs (Up to 10 Points)	Meritorious completion of hours in chapter site dance program (technique classes and group/solo/duo trio rehearsals at the studio, attendance will be monitored)	1 point per 45 hours
	Performance in chapter site dance productions. Includes rehearsal time and dress rehearsals for Company Showcase, January Showing and recital (e.g., 1 point for dress rehearsal, and performance at Company Showcase).	1 Point per Production
	Participation in chapter site extracurricular dance (e.g., taking extra classes when a guest choreographer is here, being in a guest piece including rehearsal time)	1 point per 45 hours
	Participation in chapter site dance festival or workshop (e.g., Acro intensive, or Movement Lab)	.5 points per day
Participation in Off-Site Dance Programs Note: Student must submit appropriate documentation. (Up to 10 Points) OFF SITE MEANS EVENTS NOT ASSOCIATED IN ANY WAY WITH SPOTLIGHT DANCE WORKS	Participation in off-site dance classes (e.g., taking a technique class for dance team).	1 point per 45 hours
	Performance in off-site productions, including rehearsal time. (e.g., musical at school, show choir performance)	1 point per production
	Participation in off-site dance festival or workshop, or Summer Intensive or Dance Camp (e.g., Summer Dance Sessions, Joffrey Summer Intensive)	.5 points per day
Participation in Other Dance Activities (Up to 10 Points)	Participation in a Formal Adjudication / Judging (e.g., competitions and conventions)	1 point if choreographer .5 - 1 point if dancer
	Choreography – Projects completed either inside or outside the classroom. (e.g., a choreography project in class, coming up with choreography outside of class)	1 – 2 per project (video documentation must be submitted, and point value will be determined by Ms. Shelby)
	Scholarship – Written papers, essays, or articles (e.g., essays on dance history given in class and presented to the class, reviews of live dance performances attended, journal reflections, review of dance documentaries)	.5 – 2 per essay/article (must submit to Ms. Shelby and she will determine point value)
Participation in Other Duties Related to Dance Production (Up to 10 Points)	Dance captain elected by peers and teachers (Duties handed out by teachers)	1 point per 5 months
	Photographer /Videographer (assigned to do at competitions and recital)	.5 point per production
	Make-up and hair (helping dancers at recital, competition and conventions with their make-up and hair, must include documentation of time spent and who you helped and where at)	.5 point per production
Custom School Points (Up to 10 Points)	-Mentoring (big/little): Must have documentation of activity done with big/little (e.g., meeting with them at the end of the month to discuss how things are going and writing a short report on what you talked about, getting together outside the studio to foster a closer relationship) -Helping set up and run a studio event -Being a student helper (1 point per 15 hours) -Volunteer in dressing room at recital -Participating in charity fundraisers ran by NHSDA	1 – 3 points per activity/event (Submit documentation of activity and point value will be determined by Ms. Shelby, any activity not listed must be approved prior to.

***NEW: Is it not required to obtain any points outside the studio. Students can elect to do so if they maxed out points in any given category.** To qualify for induction into the **Junior Program**, a student must earn 15 points, at least 10 of which should be earned while participating in dance activities within the program of the chapter site. To qualify for induction into the **Secondary Program**, a student must earn 30 points, at least 20 of which should be earned while participating in dance activities within the program of the chapter site. At the sponsor's discretion, a student may earn up to 5 points (Junior Program) and 10 points (Secondary Program) while participating in community dance activities or other activities in the performing arts outside of the chapter program. Prospective inductees should submit documentation (e.g., programs, signed letters of participation) for any activities outside of the chapter's program to the Chapter Sponsor.
